Dance Guidelines

- In Bronze Level, American Smooth, only closed footwork is permitted. No continuity styling.
- In closed or restricted categories, syllabi from NDCA or USA Dance member organizations should be used as a guideline.
- Open categories are not material restricted.
- American style competitions should not include International style figures (Except where permitted by the above organizations)
- In the single dance events, competitors may enter three consecutive dance levels and two consecutive age categories. (Younger and not older - except in the case of juniors or youths.) Competitors may dance in one age group no more than twice at the same level per dance.
- A couple's age classification is defined as the age of the youngest partner on the day of the event. (Except when only one person of the couple is being evaluated for proficiency)
- No lifts allowed in closed and open events. (Except in Argentine Tango, open levels) A lift is when both feet of one person are off the floor and therefore needs the other person to support them totally.
- Solo Exhibitions music should be submitted (cued and identified) on flash drive to the DJ no later than one hour prior to the event. The maximum time is three minutes including entrance and exit. Props are allowed.
- The Organizers reserve the right to merge any categories.
